Frames: <u>assumptions</u> people make about their knowledge, saying, "This is *where* belief begins." M. Night Shyalaman explains in his movie *Signs* about the two ways people view the world.



Faith: <u>beliefs or worldviews</u> for which people declare, "This is *what* I believe." Francis Schaeffer tells the story of a Swiss Alps hiker and why "faith" is not a "blind leap."



Facts: evidences of knowledge people point to telling, "This is why I believe." What is the difference between scientific truths and historical truths?



Feelings: reactions people express about their beliefs shouting, "This is how I believe." Why are decisions based on emotion a bad idea?
